

YOUR SAFETY FIRST. VACCINATION & MASKING POLICIES

Long Beach Camerata Singers is thrilled to be returning to the stage with our 2021-2022 season. We are adhering to City of Long Beach and The Long Beach Convention Center Guidelines to protect our patrons, musicians, volunteers and staff. Your safety is our number one priority. By implementing these guidelines, we hope to make you feel comfortable and safe – but we can't do it alone. We ask that you join us and play your part in providing a safe space for all who wish to enjoy world-class music by following these guidelines and contacting us with any questions. You will be notified as the season progresses should any changes be made to the policies below.

PATRON VACCINATION POLICY

Proof of full vaccination will be required for everyone attending LBCS concerts as well as all staff and artists working the events.

"Fully vaccinated" means the first visit is at least 2 weeks after the final vaccine dose. Along with their ticket, attendees will need to bring a photo ID and either their physical vaccination card, a picture of their vaccination card, or a digital vaccination record. All California residents may request a digital vaccination record at MyVaccineRecord.cdph.ca.gov.

At this time, guests under the age of 12 who are not yet eligible for vaccination may not attend events. As soon as children under the age of 12 become eligible to receive a vaccine, fully vaccinated children will be welcomed back to LBCS concerts.

If the patron will not be fully vaccinated by the date of the planned visit, the patron may return tickets for a credit on the patron's account or request a full refund by emailing our administrator at administrator@lbcamerasingers.org. Patrons who cannot comply with this Policy will be unable to enjoy LBCS events until such time as they can provide proof of full vaccination.

MASK POLICY

The Long Beach Department of Public Health requires all guests, regardless of vaccination status, wear masks at indoor public gatherings.

Guests must wear a mask unless they are actively eating and drinking or are otherwise exempt from wearing a mask due to a disability, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.). Patrons are encouraged to wear a mask with two or more layers to be worn over the nose and mouth and under the chin. The following are prohibited: Masks with exhalation valves; masks made of loosely woven fabrics; scarves, buffs, bandanas, gaiters, and face shields alone (inadequate protection). Masks will be available upon request.

Patrons who do not comply with this Policy will be removed from or denied access to any LBSA sponsored event until further notice.

We continue to monitor guidance from local, state, and national authorities and may adjust at any
